Can you find a way to remember the memory verse together?

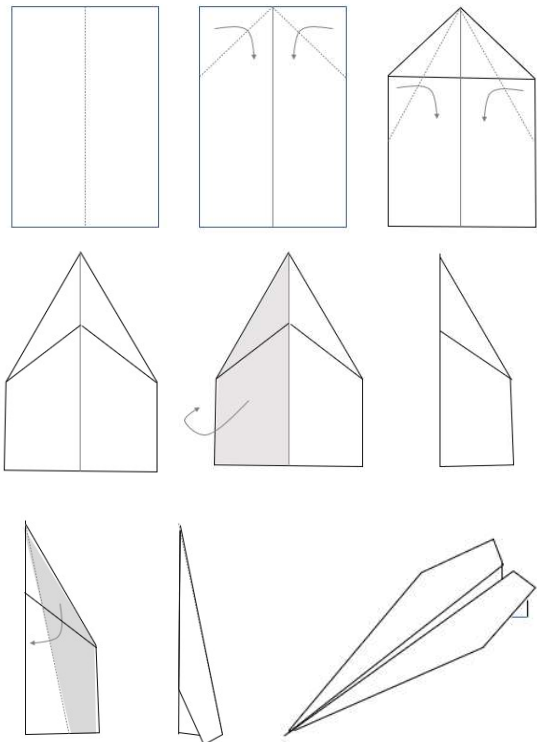
Memory Verse
